## About Boulder County Farmers Markets

Boulder County Farmers Markets is a 501 (c)4 non-profit organization dedicated to strengthening our food system by supporting, promoting, and expanding access to locally grown and made products for all members of our community. We do this by operating seasonal farmers markets (including the Boulder and Longmont Farmers Markets) and a year-round online marketplace that connect and strengthen relationships between local farmers, producers, and enthusiastic eaters.

## Position Description

Boulder County Farmers' Markets (BCFM) is looking for a part-time Market Staff for the 2023 season. Positions are open for Boulder or Longmont on Saturdays for the season (April 1st-November 18th) and in Boulder on Wednesdays (May 3rd-October 4th). BCFM is seeking energetic and collaborative individuals who are self-starters capable of working independently and in teams, able to multitask and handle a wide variety of job responsibilities. Candidates should have a passion for food and enjoy a physical work environment.

At a minimum, candidates should be able to work from 5:30am- 3:30pm on Saturdays April- November and/or 2pm-9pm Wednesdays May-October. This position will begin late March for training prior to the first Saturday market on April 1st. Saturday only or Wednesday only positions are available.

## Responsibilities

Market Staff will assist in everything from setting up the market, to running our information booth, to breaking down the market at the end of the day. This includes helping staff our market information booth, selling merchandise, communicating with vendors and customers, managing our Eco-Cycle program, enforcing market policies, welcoming customers and a variety of other tasks required to operate a vibrant community event each week.

- Is passionate about local food and community!
- Is collaborative, patient and communicative.
- Follows directions thoroughly and asks questions.
- Has excellent problem solving skills.
- Enjoys multitasking, physically demanding work and being outside.
- Has a sense of humor and is able to adapt when things don't go according to plan.
- Will develop positive relationships with customers, vendors, community and fellow team members and can communicate in a compassionate and direct manner.
- Is punctual, dependable, and respectful of company time and resources
- Preferred prior experience working in the hospitality industry, farmers market, or farm setting.
- Is able to work long days in all weather conditions: we are an all weather market!
- Has the ability to lift 50+ pounds and to stand and walk for hours at a time.
